

MALAWI FLOODS REPORT



Chikwawa and Nchalo

Over the past few days the tropical storm ANA has affected thousands of people across southern African including Malawi. The storm caused heavy rainfall and flooding. In Malawi the worst hit areas are Chikwawa - Nchalo and Nsanje districts. Many people have died and properties destroyed and washed away.

Currently people have got no food, no shelter, no water and no electricity. The government is not even doing anything as it is already struggling in meeting its national economy needs. People are starving, sanitation is compromised and the situation is just very dare unless some intervention is done.

On the other hand, YCD organization with financial support (CHF2500) from PATIMALAWI has given food (10kgs bags of maize flour) to 789 people. This food will last them for 10 days. The pictures below show the work of YCD and PATIMALAWI in supporting flood victims.



However, there are still many others who have stayed for days without any food. More support is much needed if at all lives are to be saved from hunger.
